Eimskip manages the Company's operations according to applicable laws, regulations, and international conventions by implementing measures to prevent pollution and reduce emission from its operation.



































The Company aims to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across its operations and build resilience to climate change impacts. This includes improving the energy efficiency of the Company's vessels, trucks and other equipment, exploring alternative green fuels and eco-friendly technologies and optimizing logistics routes for reduced fossil fuel consumption. Eimskip has set a goal to achieve net-zero emissions by 2040 in its own operation scope 1 and 2.

- Set action plan to reach Greenhouse gas (GHG) emission goal and review yearly
- Measure and monitor greenhouse gas emissions regularly
- Consider environmental factors when selecting equipment
- Map up physical climate risk exposure in the operation and build resilience






Eimskip has identified and controls potential environmental risks posed by the Company's operations. This includes the operation's risk of pollution on air, water, and soil. Eimskip emphasizes the use of best practices for prevention and control measures and continually seeks new solutions to mitigate its environmental footprint.

- Monitoring plan in place
- Measure and monitor main risk factors
- Emphasis on preventive measures across the operation including preventive training at least yearly
- Procedures in place to react and minimize the effect if an accident occurs

Eimskip operates according to the International Safety Management (ISM) Code onboard vessels based on the International Maritime Organization (IMO) standard for the safe management and operation of ships at sea.






Biodiversity and Ecosystem

The importance of preserving biodiversity and protecting ecosystems in the regions where Eimskip operates is recognized.

The Company is dedicated to adhering to all applicable environmental standards and strives to reduce the negative effects of its operations on nearby ecosystems, with special consideration to maritime areas, including, but not limited to, vessel ballast water handling.





Eimskip follows circular economy principles by actively reducing waste, extending equipment lifespan, and promoting reuse and recycling. The Company prioritizes repurposed or recycled materials and works towards lowering single-use resources.

- Promote preventive maintenance procedures to exceed the lifetime of equipment.
- Reuse material for cargo handling
- Active waste management in place with monitoring and measurement
- procedures for end-of-life management of equipment
- Increases percentage of recycled plastic in films to stabilize cargo, seek other options for stabilizing cargo
- Continue with partnerships with other companies focusing on reusing material for different purposes, e.g., timber pallets and plastic films



Review

This policy is approved by the Executive Management. Operation and Domestic Iceland are responsible for Eimskip Environmental Policy and will initiate audits of it every two years or as necessary to reflect changes in the Company's environment and risk landscape.
